## Stellabration Wine Cozies By Annette Corsino-Blair/The Knitting Tree, L.A.



These festive wine cozies make it an even better day to Stellabrate! They knit up quick and add fun to any party! The first pattern (A) is beginner friendly, and the second (B) is more suited for advanced beginner.

A. Level - Beginner

**Materials**: 100 yards of worsted weight (number 4) yarn. We used Cascade 220 Superwash Wave (100% superwash wool).

Size 8 Knitting Needles 1 yard of 1 inch ribbon Tapestry Needle Scissors

**Stitches Used**: **K**=Knit, **YO**=bring yarn to the front before knitting the next stitch (creates an eyelet hole), **K2tog**= knit 2 stitches together as if they are 1, \*\*=repeat instructions between asterisks

Gauge: 4.5 sts per inch


## Instructions:



**Bottom** (measures 3" X 3")
Cast on 14 stitches
Knit all rows until piece measures 3" from cast on
Bind off all stitches loosely

**Body** (measures 9" X 12")
Cast on 40 stitches
Knit all rows until piece measures 9"
Next row: \* K6, YO, K2tog\* repeat across row
Next row: Knit all stitches until piece measures 12" from cast on Bind off loosely

Using mattress stitch, sew seam on the right side of work Sew bottom to body using a whip stitch, tucking corners slightly as you sew. Weave in ends Weave ribbon through piece





## B. Level - Advanced Beginner

**Materials**: 100 yards of worsted weight (number 4) yarn. We used Cascade 220 Superwash Wave (100% superwash wool).

Size 8 Knitting Needles

1 yard each of green and brown yarn for embroidery (optional)

**Tapestry Needle** 

Scissors

**Gauge**: 4.5 stitches per inch 18 stitches and 24 rows = 4" X 4"

Stitches used: Stitches Used: K=Knit, P=Purl, \*\*=repeat instructions between asterisks

**Instructions** Bottom (measures 3" X3")

Cast on 14 sts

Row 1: \*K2, P2\* repeat across row Row 2: \*P2, K2\* repeat across row

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until piece measures 3"

Bind off loosely

Body (measures 12" X 9")

Cast on 40 stitches

Rows 1-10: (ribbing): \*K2, P2\*, repeat across row

Row 11: Knit row Row 12: Purl row

Repeat rows 11 and 12 until piece measures 8" from cast on

Rib section

\*K2, P2\*, repeat across row

Repeat row until piece measures 12" from cast on Bind off loosely leaving a long tail for sewing



Sew together on right side using mattress stitch Sew bottom to body using whip stitch

## **Optional Embroidery**

Using Brown yarn and tapestry needle, back stitch branch Using green yarn, french knot cluster of grapes and leaves







"Collar" can be used up or down for different looks
